**N**ajath College of Science and Technology, Karuvarakundu, recognaized by the Govt.of Kerala, affiliated to University of Calicut was established in 2004 with the aims of catering to the educational requirements of the area and its surroundings and of creating a peaceful and progressive atmosphere for encouraging the conduct of intellectual enquiries and for facilitating of personal development. As an educational institution run by Darunnajath Islamic Centre, the NCST has its own reputation for discipline, efficiency and maintenance of standard. The credit of all this goes first and foremost to late Jb. K.T. Manu Musliar, the Honorable founder of the Centre, who must also be remembered for the invaluable contributions he made towards its development.

#### Location

The College with its elegantly constructed buildings supplied with all necessary amenities lies in a pleasant green valley which presents an inspiring scenery and contains an atmosphere ideal for the peaceful pursuit of knowledge. The occasion of formally devoting the building to the public was celebrated on 24 May 2008 and the ceremony was graced by the presence of Mr. R.L. Bhatia, the then Governor of Kerala. The Exact location of the institute is at Kannath - Veetichola, which is hardly a kilometer away from Karuvarakundu Kizhakkethala Bus stand.

# Management

The College is run by Darunnajath Islamic Centre (a registered organization under the Societies Registration Act 1860, and it has been granted Minority Status by the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions, Govt. of India). ## Scholarships & Awards

- Post Metric scholarship for minority students- Post metric scholarship for minorities is provided by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and is reserved for the students belonging to minority communities. The eligibility of the scholarship is to secure not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade is the previous final examination and the annual income whose parent /guardian from all source does not exceed Rs. 2 lakh.
- Central Sector Scholarship- The Central Sector scheme of scholarship for college and university students is uncompleted by the department of higher education since 2008. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the minorities students to meet a part of their day to day expenses while pursing higher studies.

#### **Admission Process**

- Application for admission should be submitted online at the University website www.cuonline.ac.in as per directions from University of Calicut.
- 50% of the seats are filled on the basis of the general merit list asper the allotment of University Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) and filling of the remaining 50% is the prerogative of the Management (Which would be generally referred as the managements quota).
- For Admission in the management quota, application form and prospectus can be had on payment of Rs.100/- from the college office and application should be submitted at the office along with the copy of online submission print out.
- Application forms for management quota can be accessed and submitted online at www.najathcst.com/admission.
- Details of additional Language chosen and preference of core subjects (first, second, third) are to be clearly and carefully entered.
- Print out of online submission should be attached with the application.
- List of candidates selected for admission will be displayed on the notice board. Candidates are directed to consult the same and appear for interview at the scheduled time.
- Issue of the interview letter or notification of provisional selection list does not guarantee admission. Admission will be confirmed only after interview and verification of certificates.
- The Parent or guardian should accompany the student at the time of interview for admission.

- The candidates selected provisionally for admission are to produce the following certificates in orginal at the time of interview.
  - 1. CAP ID Printout 2. Qualifying certificates and Photocopies 3. Transfer certificate
  - 4. Conduct certificate 5. SSLC Book 6. Admit Card 6. One passport size photo
  - 8. Fees as shown in the Chart 9. Sports & Games Certificate (For Sports Quota).
- Fee Concession
- Fee concession/scholarship will be granted to SC/ST and OBC, based up on merit and means.

Note: It is informed that the college does not accept donations for management quota admission, kindly bring such malpractice to the notice of Administrative Officer/Principal/Nodel officer immediately.

## **Rules of General Discipline**

- Maintaining of discipline at the college constitutes a matter of great importance.
- Attendance: Punctuality and regular attendance are compulsory.
- Attendance and progress certificates are required for student to be eligible to write University exams unless he/she has attended not less than 75%.
- If a student is absent without submitting the leave form his/her name will be removed from the roll.
- The student who fails to earn 75% of attendance will be permitted to appear for exam only after producing a condonation of shortage of attendance from the University.
- Ragging: As per the order of Supreme Court, High Court, UGC, Govt. of Kerala and University of Calicut ragging is strictly prohibited inside and outside of the campus.
- Ragging is a criminal offence punishable with imprisonment up-to two years or a fine or both and non bailable. Anti-ragging cell is also functioning in the college.
- Cellphone: Cell phones are strictly banned within the bounds of the campus as per the order of the Hon. High Court of Kerala.
- College properties should be handled with utmost care. Students should not disfigure the walls, windows or furniture by writing on them or sticking bills.
- Students shall not loiter on Veranadhas and campus during class hours
- Students should not enter other class rooms without permission.
- Indecent behavior towards staff and fellow students will entail punishment.
- Dress: All the students are to be obliged to strictly observe the dress code while attending the college.
- Students shall wear uniform on all the days fixed by the authority.
- The Dress worn by students shall always be clean, sober and dignified.
- Men Students should not wear T-Shirt and Women Students shall observe strict modesty and dignity in dressing. The particulars of modesty and dignity will be the discretion of the college authority.
- They should avoid dresses with low neck, short or sleeveless blouse, miniskirts, Jeans, tight/short tops, tops with slits or transparent clothing.
